



Zookeepers is a boisterous producer duo consisting of William de Waal and Søren Oliver Due. They excite and surprise their audience with an energetic futuristic sound in beautiful combination with melodious pop realms, and they already have more than 50 million streams worldwide. During this year they will be playing more than 100 concerts throughout Denmark.

Zookeepers are growing at a fast pace, gaining support from some of the biggest names in their field, including producers such as Diplo, NGHTMRE, Jauz and Tiësto. Furthermore, they have collaborated with artists such as Snavs, Ship Wrek and Toby Green.

Zookeepers' latest hit 'Can't Fall Asleep' featuring Danish pop queen Clara has proven to be the duo's biggest radio hit to date, entering the airplay chart at #3 and was appointed as "Unavoidable Track Of The Week (Ugens Uundgåelige)" at the largest radio station in Denmark, P3.

At the moment the duo is closing a track featuring the biggest pop diva in the history of Danish pop music, Medina. She has won multiple awards, including 5 Danish Music Awards, and she was named Best Danish Act three years in a row at MTV EMA. The track, 'Who Do You Love' takes after 'Can't Fall Asleep' and is inspired by UK house.

American labels are showing their interest for Zookeepers (Columbia (NY) and Astralwerks (LA)), and Relentless Records (UK) will be working forthcoming singles from the duo.
